Why is TEC hosting the network?



What are we going to do?

- **Host speakers** who can provide insight and guidance on topics of interest. The network would facilitate the organization and discussion around this for the benefit of all members of group.
- Facilitation of **engagement with citizens** which can be analysed and discussed within the network, to maximise benefits and provide access to citizens which might not be possible to do in each local area.
- Controlled **interaction with industry** so members do not feel “mined for information”
- Eventually be able to provide **different channels as topics diverge**. An example would be channels for those interested specifically in voice assistant development or for those who are interested in separate aspects such as the use of wearables.
- Ensuring **member coverage** from areas such as housing, care homes and condition specific e.g., dementia to increase both the pool of knowledge and the potential for sharing practice.
- As a group, being able to pool resources to make the case for **standardisation of procurement processes**. Can reflect critical issues to those with strategic influence and demonstrate these are not isolated cases of need.
- Provide **updates and information** on improved devices, additional features, functionality and new tech on the market to the wider social care, housing and health sectors.

Next Steps

- Establish a small steering group to look at scope and remit of network



- Create a space where people can share ideas and discuss solutions and benefits



- Build a community of practice to allow knowledge and skills transfer



- Develop and grow over next 6 months to engage more stakeholders and become an invaluable, trusted national resource
