

# Setting up an iCloud account

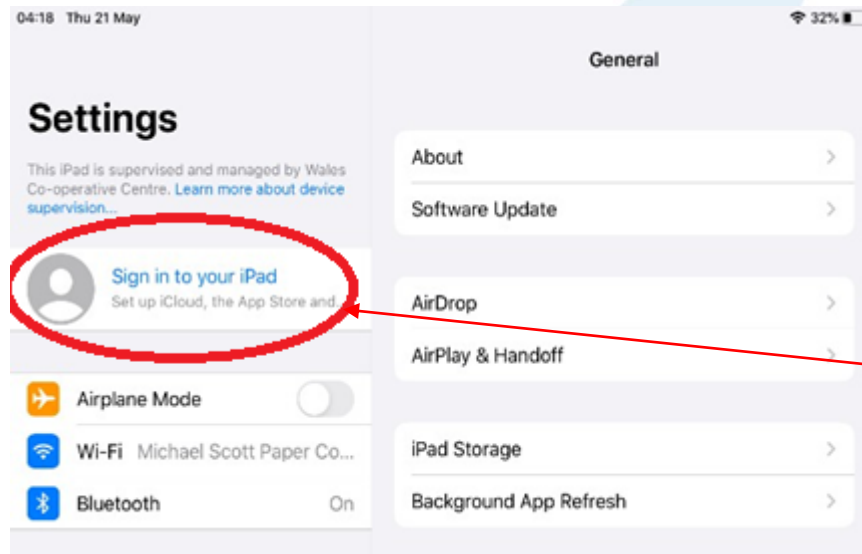
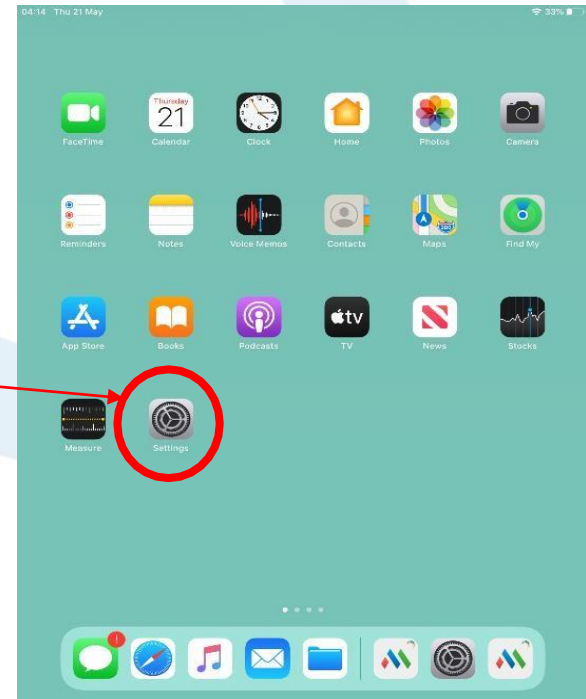

## Step 1

To set up an iCloud account you will need to click onto settings on the device.



## Step 2

The settings screen will open. Press 'Sign in to your iPad' on the top left hand corner

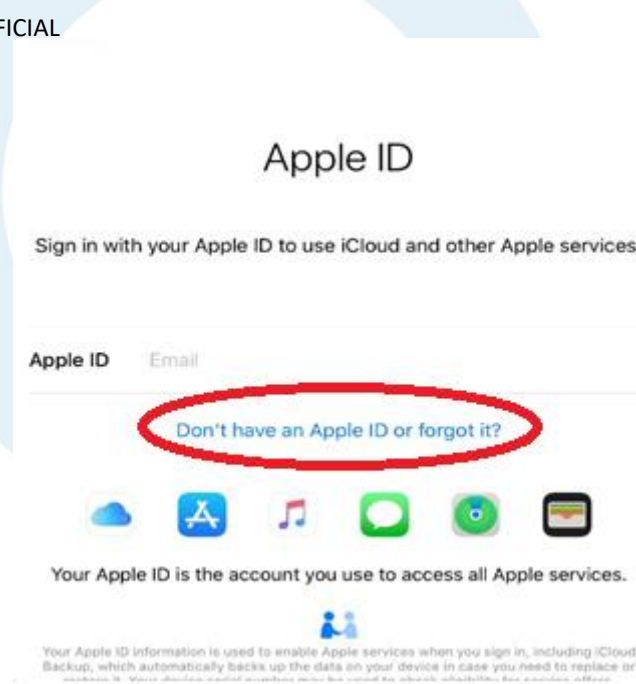

You will then see an 'Apple ID' screen:

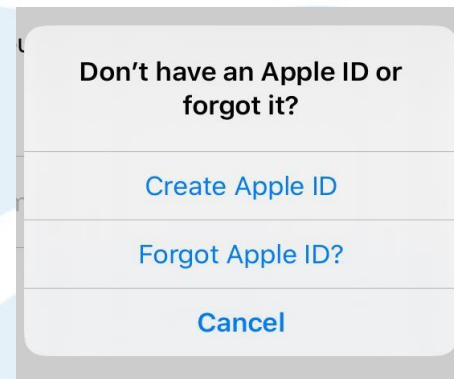
Select the option which says "Don't have an Apple ID or forgot it?"

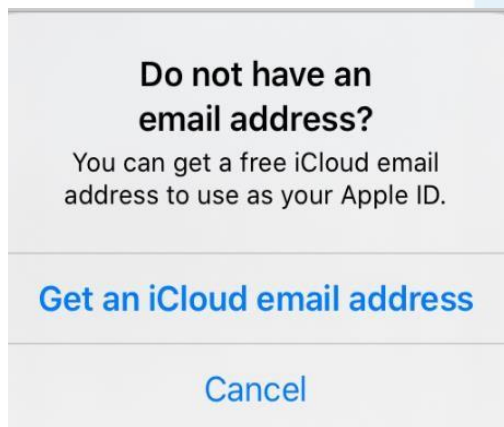

## Step 6

Follow the steps for "Create email address"

You will then be prompted to enter a password, once you have done this click 'next'.

Once you have entered a password you will be asked to select from a list and provide answers to 3 security questions.

Think carefully as to how and where these details could be stored if members of the team need them in future.

They must be kept securely and away from the device.

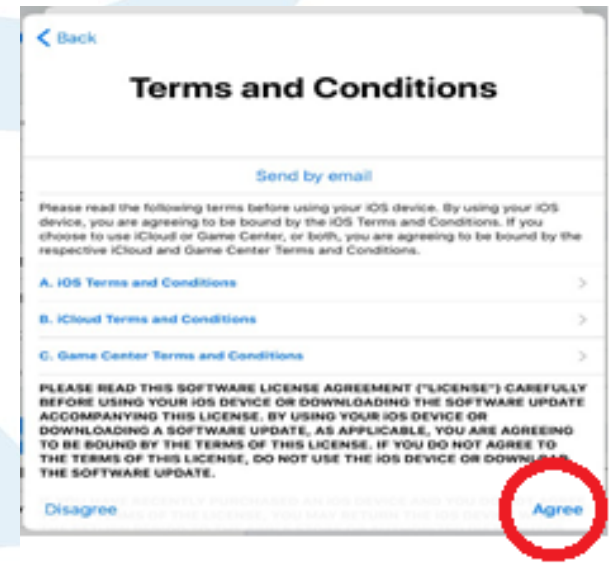

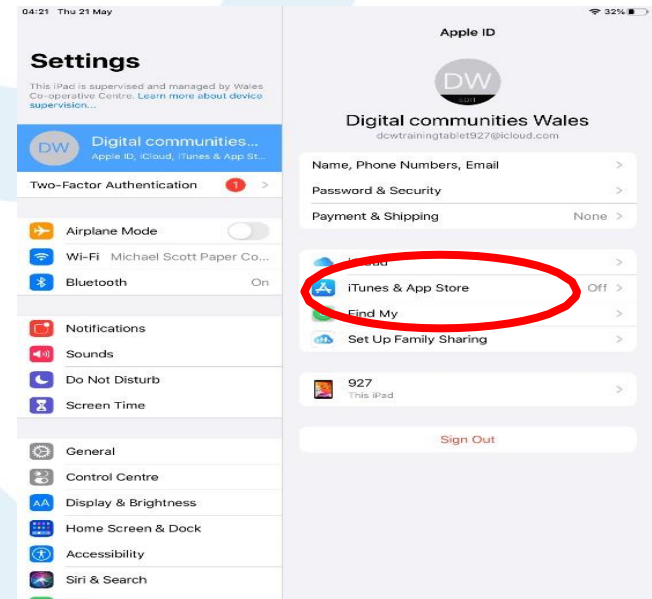

To use this account in the app store, you will need to link the iCloud account to iTunes.

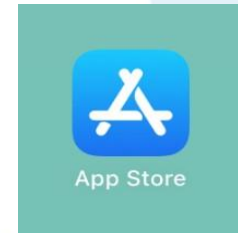
To do this, on the settings screen you will see the option for iTunes and app store.
